#### **Purpose**

This document provides you with key information about this investment product. It is not marketing material. The information is required by law to help you understand the nature, risks, costs, potential gains and losses of this product and to help you compare it with other products.

You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

### 1. What is this product?

### Type

This product is issued under Austrian law and entitles the respective holder to receive any amount due from us as the Issuer

#### **Term**

#### **Objectives**

The product has a fixed term and will be due on 18 November 2026.

The product is designed to provide a return in the form of (1) a conditional coupon payment and (2) a cash payment on the maturity date. The amount of this payment will depend on the performance of the underlyings.

Coupon: On the maturity date you will receive a cash payment directly linked to the performance of the worst performing underlying. The cash payment will equal (i) CZK 3,000 (i.e., 300.00% of the product notional amount) multiplied by (ii) (x) (A) the reference level of the worst performing underlying on the immediately preceding coupon observation date divided by (B) its initial reference level minus (y) 120.00%. However, if this cash payment exceeds CZK 450, you will only receive CZK 450 and if it is less than CZK 0.00, you will receive CZK 0.00.

Termination on the maturity date: On termination of the product on the maturity date you will receive:

- if the final reference level of the worst performing underlying is above 60.00% of its initial reference level, a cash payment equal to CZK 1,200; or
- if the final reference level of the worst performing underlying is at or below 60.00% of its initial reference level, a cash payment directly linked to the performance of the worst performing underlying. The cash payment will equal (i) the product notional amount multiplied by (ii) (A) the final reference level of the worst performing underlying divided by (B) its initial reference level.

Under the product terms, certain dates specified below will be adjusted if the respective date is either not a business day or not a trading day (as applicable). Any adjustments may affect the return, if any, you receive.

The product terms also provide that if certain exceptional events occur (1) adjustments may be made to the product and/or (2) the issuer may terminate the product early. These events are specified in the product terms and principally relate to the underlyings, the product and the issuer. The return (if any) you receive on such early termination is likely to be different from the scenarios described above and may be less than the amount you invested.

#### Intended retail client

## Recommended holding period: 3 years and 6 months

The product aims to provide you with the return described under "1. What is this product?" above. However, this only applies if the product is held to maturity. It is therefore recommended that the product is held until 18 November 2026 (maturity).

The product does not guarantee the possibility to disinvest other than by selling the product either (1) through the exchange (if the product is exchange traded) or (2) off-exchange, where an offer for such product exists. No fees or penalties will be charged by the issuer for any such transaction, however an execution fee might be chargeable by your broker if applicable. By selling the product before its maturity, you may receive back less than you would have received if you had kept the product until maturity.
