

## YIELD OPPORTUNITY WITH SUSTAINABLE INVESTING

The USD Premium ESG Protected Certificate enables investors to obtain 100% of the nominal value and a coupon at the predetermined rate of 35% (7.00% annually/6.17% p.a.) in case the MSCI® World Top ESG Select 4.5% Decrement index increases by 17% and more compared to the starting value at the end of the term. Otherwise, investors receive a coupon at the predetermined rate of 17% (3.40% annually/3.18% p.a.) in addition to 100% of the nominal value.

In recent years, people have increasingly focused on environmental, social and governance (ESG) criteria not only in everyday decisions, but also in investing. Therefore, many investors have become interested in investing in the stock market of sustainable companies, but may still be concerned about the full market risk. The USD Premium ESG Protected Certificate, which is based on the global index of sustainable stocks from the renowed company MSCI®, can be the solution to this dilemma.

### How the certificate works

At the initial valuation date, the starting value of the MSCI® World Top ESG Select 4.5% Decrement Index is determined (closing price as of Sep 28, 2023). At the end of the term, the performance of the MSCI® World Top ESG Select 4.5% Decrement Index is evaluated. This means that at the final valuation date (Sep 26, 2028) the index closing price is compared to the starting value. At the final valuation date one **of the following scenarios applies:** 

### 1. Index performance ≥ 17 % from the Starting value

→ 35% coupon and redemption at 100% of the nominal value
In addition to the 100% of the nominal value, investors obtain the coupon of 35% of the nominal value (equals USD 350 per USD 1,000 nominal value).

### 2. Index performance < 17 % from the Starting value

→ 17% coupon and redemption at 100% of the nominal value

In addition to the 100% of the nominal value, investors obtain the coupon of 17% of the nominal value (equals USD 170 per USD 1,000 nominal value).

### Permanent liquidity




