

How the certificate works

On the initial valutation date, the starting value of the underlying is determined and based on that the barrier and the termination levels are defined. On the respective annual valuation date, the price of the underlying is compared with the respective termination level. If there has been no early redemption by the last year of the term and if the price of the underlying is also below the termination level (corresponds to the barrier) on the final valuation date, physical delivery of shares is effected:

Physical delivery of shares

A defined number of shares is booked into the investor's securities account. The number is calculated as follows:

Number of shares = Nominal value / starting value

Usually this does not result in whole numbers. Due to the fact that shares are traded in whole numbers only, in the event of physical delivery the residual value is paid out in cash (= cash settlement) according to the market value:


