Issuer Risk:

As a bearer bond, a certificate is not subject to Austria's deposit protection. What You Should Consider Before the Purchase:

- **Market risk:** The price of the Bonus Certificate is dependent on the underlying's performance. An unfavourable performance of the underlying may result in price fluctuations of the certificate during the term. This may result in a partial or even total loss of the invested capital.
- **Barrier event:** If the barrier of the Bonus Certificate is touched or undercut during the term, the protection mechanism is suspended. In this case, the investor is exposed to the market risk on a one-to-one basis and a substantial capital loss is possible. The redemption at the end of the term is then usually one-to-one with the underlying performance.
- **Price performance:** During the term, the certificate's price is not only dependent on the underlying's performance but on various influencing factors such as the underlying's volatility, interest rates, issuer's solvency or remaining term. 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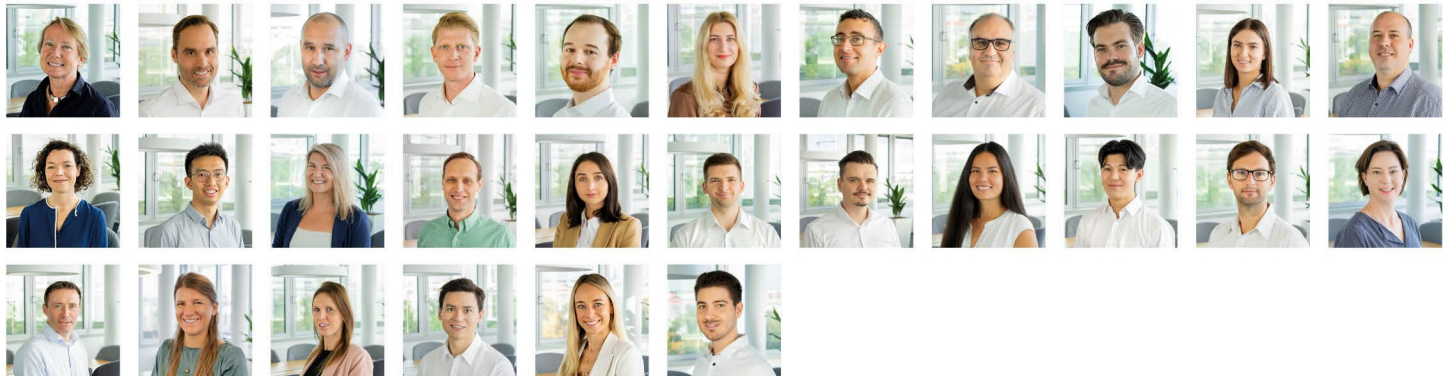
